SDCET, Muzaffarnagar was established in 1997 by the Sanatan Dharam College Association, a registered pioneer educational society. SDCET is offering M.Tech course in Electronics & Communication and B.Tech degree courses in Civil Engg, Electrical Engg., Computer Science & Engg., Chemical Engg., Electronics & Comm. Engg., Mechanical Engg., Bio-Technology and Information Technology apart from Diploma courses in Civil Engg., Mechanical Production, Mechanical Automobile & Electrical Engg. Fifteen batches have already passed out from the college. Computer Science, Electronics & Communication and Chemical Engg. branches are accredited by NBA. SDCMS has been imparting education in MBA, MCA, BBA and BCA courses approved by AICTE and affiliated to APJAK Technical University, Lucknow and CCS University, Meerut.
